As the "crime of crimes," against the biological existence of a people, and human diversity as such, the paradigmatic case of the Holocaust has been extended to include at least three other major such examples for what Raphael Lemkin would define as genocide.

This lecture will provide an historical survey of cases of such coordinated destruction of the organic foundation of distinct populations including Namibia (Herero and Namaqua genocide), Armenia, Cambodia and Rwanda. Accordingly these remarks will highlight, in a comparative analysis, features shared and dissimilar with the Holocaust and these other cases of death penalties dealt to whole peoples.
